

BOOK I: THE ACCIDENTAL APPRENTICE 🍄

The last thing Barclay Thorne ever wanted was an adventure.

Thankfully, as an apprentice to the town's mushroom farmer, Barclay need only work hard and follow the rules to one day become the head mushroom farmer himself. No danger required. But then Barclay accidentally breaks his town's most sacred rule: never ever EVER stray into the Woods, for within the Woods lurk vicious magical Beasts.

To Barclay's horror, he faces a fate far worse than being eaten: he unwittingly bonds with a Beast and is run out of town by an angry mob. Determined to break this bond and return home, Barclay journeys to find the mysterious town of Lore Keepers, people who have also bonded with Beasts and share their powers.

But after making new friends, entering a dangerous apprenticeship exam, and even facing the legendary Beast of the Woods, Barclay must make a difficult choice: return to the home and rules he's always known, or embrace the adventure awaiting him.



VISIT DETAILS

Each visit typically includes:



- ✓ 1 hour long, assembly-style presentation
- ✓ 1-2 more hour-long blocks for additional presentations or workshops
- ✓ Free autographed posters for every student in attendance
- ✓ A book signing with students

PRESENTATION

The presentation, “**How To Build a Magical Adventure**,” walks through how Amanda constructed *The Accidental Apprentice*, using Barclay’s adventure as context to explore storytelling concepts like plot, character, setting, and theme.

It’s ideal for **grades 2-6** and is designed both for readers familiar with Wilderlore and for newcomers to the series.

Among the opening slides, Amanda reveals how Pokémon was her childhood obsession and inspiration for the story—as well as other franchises like *Avatar: the Last Airbender*, *Naruto*, *How To Train Your Dragon*, and more. Without fail, so many faces light up, especially from kids who weren’t expecting a real-life author to share their love for their own favorite TV shows and video games. It’s validating, and it can be a confidence boost to those intimidated by reading. Which is why so many educators have said that even some of their most reluctant readers eagerly began Wilderlore after the presentation—it makes an approachable and intriguing invitation to the world of books.

This presentation includes a “Create Your Own Beast” activity that requires basic craft supplies and is suitable even to large auditorium settings. It keeps students engaged and helps them imagine themselves into the story.

The presentation lasts 45 minutes and is followed by a 15-minute student Q&A, for a total of **one hour**. The only equipment necessary is a projector.

WORKSHOPS

Most schools request to use all their blocks for additional presentations, allowing each one to be split into smaller groups of students. However, Amanda offers other options as well. These include:

- ✔ Classroom creative writing workshop
- ✔ Classroom Q&A
- ✔ Lunch with small group of students
- ✔ “Becoming an author” career presentation

Each block last one hour, but their length can be modified to better suit the school’s schedule.

Amanda is also happy to meet the unique needs of each school. If there is a particular topic or event request for the visit that doesn’t match any on this list, that can absolutely be discussed and included.

BOOK ORDERS

As students often finish the visits excited to read the books, Amanda asks that schools offer the opportunity for students to order copies in advance of the visit. Amanda will sign all copies the day of the visit, either with the students in person or solo to then be distributed to students later, according to the school's preference.

Because Amanda likes to give all students something special to take home, she will bring signed posters for all students, regardless of order numbers.

As we begin coordinating a visit, Amanda will reach out to the closest store to handle book orders. She's always happy to work with a preferred vendor if your school has one to recommend.

An order form can be provided, whether hard copy or online. **Orders typically need to be placed two weeks in advance to ensure that copies can make it to the school in time for the visit.**

For any books ordered after the visit, Amanda can send the school or store signed bookplates, which are stickers that can be placed into a book to turn it into a "signed" copy.

Students who already own the books are more than welcome to bring their copies from home for Amanda to sign.
